

Week 5 Preview: Mosinee vs Antigo

Week five will pin a Mosinee (2-2 1-1conf.) verses Great Northern Conference opponent the Antigo Red Robin (3-1). Antigo is 1-0 in Great Northern Conference play with a shut out win against Ashland 46-0. Mosinee didn't fare as well as they lost a high scoring affair against Medford. The challenge for Mosinee this week will be how will they bounce back. The tough loss against Medford came right as the season begins to heat up. One of the biggest things Mosinee needs to work on this week will be how does their defense stop the run. Conrad Bolz put up a impressive 181 yards on 16 carries while Medford's second back Josh Thiede put 67 on 15 carries with 3 scores to boot. It'll be extremely important for Mosinee to stop the run this week as Antigo is another offense that runs the ball effectively. Of Antigo's 278 offensive yards 243 of them are on the ground. Their five offensive touchdowns have also came on the ground. Antigo's offensive will be anchored around the play of their senior running back, Max Nowinsky. As well as support from senior quarterback Alex Nagel and the other running back, junior, William Dixon. Mosinee on offensive will look to senior quarterback Landon Stepan for another great game as the offensive continues to struggle with their rush offensive. Stepan is averaging 216 yards per game and has be nothing short of great for the team thus far this year. Look for Mosinee to try and stay a balanced offense in the beginning of the game but if that doesn't work, they turn to Stepan and the pass offense.
